OF SEWP VI CONTRACTS

Scope

The scope of SEWP VI will include **both ITC/AV** (Information Technology, Communication and Audio Visual) **solutions** in *Category A* along with a **full suite of ITC/AV services** in *Categories B* and *C*.

In response to changes in technology, **the scope of available products in *Category A* will be expanded.**



Scope Details

Products:

- SEWP VI scope additions: A few exciting additions include **Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR)**, robotics, the Internet of Things, as well as law enforcement and national security equipment and technology.

Services:

- SEWP V: A product solutions contract that has also provided product-related services
- SEWP VI: An *ITC/AV product solutions contract* as well as an *ITC/AV services contract*

Customer Significance: Customers that were unable to leverage the SEWP Contracts for pure IT services that fell outside the scope of SEWP I-V will be able to leverage SEWP VI as an option to meet their agency and mission needs.

The SEWP VI website will provide detailed information regarding the scope of SEWP VI.



NAICS Codes

NAICS code selection:

- SEWP V: NAICS code is **334111** for *Group A* and the NAICS code is **541519** for *Groups B, C and D*
- SEWP VI: Customers ***will have the ability to select the appropriate NAICS code*** when completing their request in the Quote Request Tool (QRT).
 - This information *must* be on the order and will be entered into the SEWP order database.

SEWP VI Categories:

Category A: ITC/AV (*Information Technology, Communications and Audio Visual*) Solutions

Category B: Enterprise-Wide ITC/AV Services

Category C: ITC/AV Mission-Oriented Services



NAICS Codes (cont.)

Unique SEWP VI offering:

- Unlike many IDIQ (Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity) contracts, **SEWP VI will offer many NAICS codes.**

Small business FAQ:

How many small businesses will SEWP VI offer?

- The number of small businesses SEWP VI will offer *depends on what NAICS code the solicitation is competing under.*

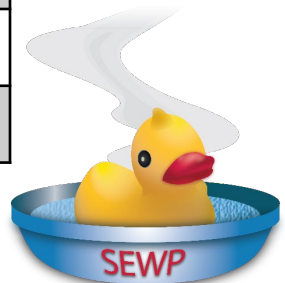

Contract Types

SEWP VI will allow for multiple contract types:

- Firm Fixed Price (currently offered in SEWP V)
- *Time and Material**
- *Labor Hour**
- *Fixed Price Award Fee**
- *Fixed Price Incentive Fee**
- *Fixed Price Economic Price Adjustment**
- *Any hybrid of commercial contract types for orders**

Contract Types (cont.)

SEWP VI Enhancement:

- New contract types will allow Agencies to obtain more ITC/AV requirements through SEWP VI.
- The **QRT** will allow users to select the contract type when sending out their request to Contract Holders.



Set-Asides

All three Scope *Categories* (A, B, and C) will allow for small business Set-asides at the order level, including:

- Women-Owned Small Business (WOSB)
- Economically Disadvantaged Women-Owned Small Business (EDWOSB)
- Historically Underutilized Business Zone (HUBZone)
- 8(a)*
- Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB)
- *Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB)**
- Small Business

Set-Asides (cont.)

SEWP VI Enhancement:

- When customers create a request using the **QRT**, they can ask Contract Holders to certify their business size at the order level at the time of quoting (if necessary).
 - *This option is available, but not required*
- SEWP will certify all Contract Holders at the time of award and will conduct standard 5-year recertifications.



SEWP Marketplace

Overview: In SEWP VI, the **SEWP Marketplace** will be defined as the entirety of SEWP, including all Contract Holder & Procurement information on our website, pricing information within our SEWP Online Catalog, all supporting applications as well as the customer service expertise offered.

Capabilities:

- All Contract Holder information and Procurement guidance is available on our redesigned website
- Users can browse & search the SEWP Online Catalog by provider, part number, and description keyword
- The **Marketplace & SEWP Online Catalog** provide extensive resources to conduct market research and analysis
- Allows direct micro-purchases and/or quote requests directly from the SEWP Online Catalog



SEWP Online Catalog

SEWP VI Enhancements:

- Allow customers to access all available CLINs (contract line item numbers)
- Able to search, create product and service lists, create shopping carts, and place orders via the SEWP Online Catalog
- Access Strategic Storefronts & BPAs available for your Agency

Customer Significance:

- The fastest contract in the Federal Government to add new solutions to contract
- The easiest way for customers to locate Contract Holders, providers, products, and services
- The ability to review what is offered in the SEWP Online Catalog *before* creating a request.
- The option to choose from many filters to narrow the scope of the search
- The inclusion of product solutions and services
- The security of knowing that *only customers* will be able to see SEWP Online Catalog details
 - *Public users and Contract Holders will not have access*



Strategic Storefronts & BPAs

Overview:

- Will replace Catalogs and Marketplaces from SEWP V
- Easily located in the SEWP Online Catalog (post-login)

SEWP VI Enhancement:

- Provides fast access to strategically-sourced products, services, and solutions.
- Strategic Storefronts & Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs) will be available through SEWP.
- NASA accepted the Revolutionary FAR Overhaul (RFO) deviation in December 2025.

Contact SEWP's **Helpdesk** (help@sewp.nasa.gov) to review the process for creating and maintaining a Storefront or BPA.



Non-Manufacturer Rule

SEWP VI will operate under specific **NMR** (nonmanufacturer rule) waivers that cover most, but not all, products in *Category A*.

- Information as to which product categories are not covered by the NMR waiver will be provided on the SEWP VI website.

SEWP VI Difference:

- The NMR will only apply to *Category A* in SEWP VI,
- SEWP has been granted class waivers for certain products.



Number of Contract Holders

It is anticipated that the number of Contract Holders will increase **significantly** in SEWP VI.

The **SEWP Program Management Office** is developing applications and tools to assist customers as they navigate the depth and breadth of Contract Holders and their capabilities.

SEWP Support:

Contract Holder Relationship Management (CHRM)/Industry Team

- The sole focus of this team is to help Contract Holders and Providers be successful
- They ensure SEWP transactions are fast, consistent, and transparent



SEWP Website

The SEWP VI website will be **redesigned** to *improve information flow and navigation*.

A *search function* will be added to the homepage so that users can *easily* find the information and details they are seeking.



Quote Request Tool (QRT)

The central SEWP Application redesign

- Accounts for all SEWP VI features/capabilities
- Improves validation options and the overall customer experience

SEWP will provide training and online videos of new applications and enhancements as they are completed and integrated into the SEWP VI overall platform.



Other Notable Differences Between V and VI

- Permitted to add Credit Card Fee to an order (*RFP, page 71*)
- Ability for SEWP to on-ramp and off-ramp Contract Holders (*RFP, page 70-71*)
- Added Dormant Status for Contract Holders (*RFP, page 69*)
- Inclusion of ISO 9001 & CMMI language and C-SCRM language (*RFP, pages 100 and 57 (respectively)*)
- Requirements related to AbilityOne as Subcontractors will be added (*RFP, page 63*)
- Ordering Contracting Officer (CO/KO) may approve/deny third party Payment Platforms at the order level (*RFP, Page 77*)
- CMMC will be added as a verifiable option in the Quote Request Tool
